



PEST CONTROL PREP for FLEAS

This pre-treatment checklist details the steps of preparation to ensure a safe and successful treatment. Your cooperation is paramount to the success of your treatment. If the structure is not properly prepared on the day of treatment; we reserve the right to refuse service.

✓ BEFORE YOUR TREATMENT:

- Please remove small items from floors. (Clothes, toys, etc.-- these items can be placed on beds, sofas, etc. temporarily so that we can have as much access to your floors as possible.)
- Run the vacuum cleaner over all floor surfaces the morning before we come. This action will agitate the flea eggs and quicken their hatching process and allow them to get into our product when it is most potent (right after we apply).
- Cover all fish tanks and turn off filters
- All occupants and pets must vacate the home for a minimum of 4 hours after treatment of the home.
- If you have a pet they *must be treated* with a prescription -grade flea treatment such as such as Bravecto- (1 pill every 3 months- super easy!) (Frontline Plus is no longer effective for fleas).

✓ AFTER YOUR TREATMENT:

- You may re-enter your home after 4 hours.
- If anything is still not dry after 4 hours or if there is still an odor- you may open windows to allow your home to "air out"
- VERY IMPORTANT - continue to run your vacuum cleaner at least once a day for the 3 days following your treatment. This will help flea eggs to hatch early and get into the treated floors when the product is most potent.
- DO NOT MOP YOUR FLOORS OR SHAMPOO OR CLEAN YOUR CARPETS FOR AT LEAST 2 WEEKS to ensure that the product has sufficient time to work.

It will take 2 to 3 treatments to completely eliminate fleas so please be aware that the treatments are a process and you will not see complete results until after all follow-ups have been completed.

PLEASE NOTE- Vacuuming will make it seem like the fleas are getting worse for the first few days but keep in mind that the product will continue to kill them and the increased activity is only temporary.

Tips for ongoing control: Ask us about treating your yard with a granular insecticide in spring and summer to get an early jump on flea and tick control before they find their way onto your pets and into your home!
